FILL OUT THE APPLICATION

Complete all parts of the attached application.

COMPLETE THE VOLUNTEER LOG

Use our volunteer log sheets to record all of your volunteer experience during your time in high school (freshman to senior year). Extra sheets can be accessed using the QR code to be printed and added to your application.

WRITE YOUR ESSAY

On the attached paper, handwrite a 1-2 page essay telling how you volunteered in the community, what you did, and how it impacted you and those you helped. **NO ESSAYS WRITTEN BY AI WILL BE ALLOWED.**

SUBMIT YOUR TRANSCRIPTS

Get an official copy of your current high school transcript. The transcript must be submitted in a sealed envelope to be considered valid, and ensure it includes your weighted GPA for all 4 years of high school. Turn in your transcript with the rest of your documents.

TURN IN YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER

An acceptance letter to a college, university, trade school, or technical school is required to be considered for this scholarship. Physical copies of these letters must be included with your application so a check made out to the school you choose to attend can be mailed.
